Enclosed is a copy of our finding of today that Sequoia Construction Company and Wade Peebles and Henry Peebles, partners in the firm, have disregarded obligations to employees within the meaning of the Davis-Bacon Act, 40 U.S.C. § 276a (1976), in the performance as a subcontractor on contract No. N68248-76-C-3011 for the construction of housing units at Naval Submarine Base, Bangor, Washington.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 3(a) of the act, the names of the above firm and individuals shall be included on our next published list of ineligible and no Government contract will be awarded to them or to any firm, corporation, partnership, or association in which they or any of them has an interest until 3 years have elapsed from that date.
