


To the President of the Senate and the

On April 23, 1990, the President submitted to the Congress his fifth special impoundment message for fiscal year 1990. This message reports three proposed rescissions of budget authority. We have reviewed these proposals and found them to be in accordance with the Impoundment Control Act, 2 U.S.C. § 681, as amended.

Enclosure I provides specific information on two of the proposals which we believe will be useful to the Congress in its examination of the message. Enclosure II provides a list of the proposals as reported by the President.

According to the most recent apportionment statement for this account, dated April 19, 1990, total budgetary resources are \$36,190,535 and not \$34,207,417 as reported in the message. The apportionment schedule reflects an additional \$1,983,118 in funds recovered under a satisfaction of judgment for a construction project at the Plum Island Animal Disease Center.^{1/}

According to the most recent apportionment schedule for this account total budgetary resources are \$201,862,000 and not \$189,056,000 as reported in the message. The apportionment schedule estimates that the Economic Development Administration will bring forward \$12,806,000 of unobligated balances.
