Dear Mr. Heard:

We have made a review for the settlement of the accounts of the certifying officers of the Mississippi State Office, Soil Conservation Service, United States Department of Agriculture. Our review, completed in March 1971, was made pursuant to the Budget and Accounting Act, 1921 (31 U.S.C. 53), and the Accounting and Auditing Act of 1950 (31 U.S.C. 67).

Our review was directed primarily toward the evaluation of administrative procedures and controls over the disbursement of funds as they relate to the responsibilities of the certifying officers, and included such tests of financial transactions as we considered appropriate. In establishing the scope of our review, we considered the results of the last audits performed by the Office of the Inspector General and the Budget and Finance Division, Washington, D. C., in November 1967 and in March 1968, respectively. We did not examine program-type activities and payroll operations.

We found that the procedures and controls over disbursements were generally satisfactory.

We wish to acknowledge the courtesies and cooperation given our representatives during the review.
