Dear Mr. Chairman:

In your letter of January 15, 1980, and during subsequent discussions with your office, concerns were expressed that increases in the cost of military training provided foreign nationals may have discouraged them from participating in Defense training programs. Your letter also requested a comparison of (1) trends over the past decade for the number of students, countries, and course costs for the International Military Education and Training Program and the Foreign Military Sales Training Program and (2) the tuition rates charged foreign nationals who participate in Defense's training programs. (See app. I.) After meeting with your office on March 26, 1980, we were requested to provide you with this report in time for congressional review of the Defense budget.

This report contains statistical data developed during our review of the Department of Defense training of foreign military personnel. In accordance with arrangements made with your office it does not contain any analysis, conclusions, recommendations, or results of our review. In addition, as agreed with your office, our overall evaluation, conclusions, and recommendations will be provided to you in a final report at a later date.



Because of the amount of information requested and the short time provided to gather this information, we were not able to verify its accuracy. Also, as requested by your office, we did not obtain comments from the Department of Defense.

Concern has been expressed that increases in the cost of military training provided to foreign nationals may have discouraged their participation in these Defense programs.


In order to pursue this matter, I would like to request that your office make a comparison of the trends over the past decade, if possible, for the number of students, countries, courses taken, course costs, etc., for the International Military Education and Training Program (IMET) and the Foreign Military Sales Training Program (FMS).

In your study, I would appreciate knowing the various types of training offered under each program and the related value of such training. Also, the Committee would like a comparison of the types of costs included in IMET courses verses those included in the FMS courses. This information will assist the Senate Foreign Relations Committee in evaluating the impact of increased course costs on participation in these training programs.

The Committee staff has discussed this review with members of your Financial and General Management Studies Division, Systems in Operation group. I would appreciate a report on this matter by April 15, 1980.

CLASSIFICATION OF TRAINING PROVIDEDFOREIGN MILITARY STUDENTS

The Department of Defense offers many different types of military training to foreign military personnel. Foreign military personnel attend classes and receive on-the-job training with Defense personnel at military installations in the United States and overseas to learn specific military skills or techniques. The courses offered include training in piloting various aircraft, maintaining aircraft, operating and maintaining communications equipment, and other technical subjects. The foreign nationals are also given managerial, administrative, and orientation training. For reporting purposes, we grouped the training provided into four classifications, which are discussed below.

TRAINING IN EQUIPMENT OPERATION

This type of training includes flight and missile training, communication and electronics training, and operational training. The first two categories are self-explanatory. Operational training includes courses in weapon tactics, amphibious operations, counterinsurgency, and combat operations. This classification includes all training that requires developing a specific skill for a particular weapon system obtained from the United States.

MANAGERIAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE TRAINING

This training includes what Defense has classified as administrative training and professional and special training. Administrative training includes courses such as personnel management. The professional and special training includes courses in English language, engineering, and construction, as well as those offered by the military departments' professional schools. These schools include the military departments' War Colleges and the Command and General Staff Colleges. This training is not directly related to a specific weapon system.

Many of the individuals who have attended these courses in the past have subsequently assumed prominent positions in their country's government. Approximately one out of every four such students has achieved the rank of general or flag officer. This training should provide them with a better understanding of the United States.

SUPPLY AND MAINTENANCE TRAINING

This classification includes courses that ensure that the weapons systems are effectively maintained and that the necessary spare and repair parts are readily available.

INDOCTRINATION AND ORIENTATION TRAINING

This training includes tours for distinguished visitors, observer training, on-the-job training, and other nonstructured training. Select students involved in this type of training become familiar with United States military life and help promote friendships between the United States and participating nations.

METHODOLOGY USED TO COMPUTE TUITION RATESFOR TRAINING PROVIDED FOREIGN STUDENTS

The elements of cost included by the military departments in computing tuition rates depends on whether the student is (1) enrolled under the International Military Education and Training Program or the Foreign Military Sales Training Program or (2) from North Atlantic Treaty Organization countries.

Defense is required by law to recover all costs incurred in training foreign students under the Foreign Military Sales Program. However, Defense is authorized by law to waive certain costs in training foreign students under the International Military Education and Training Program and in training military personnel from North Atlantic Treaty Organization countries. An explanation of costs included in tuition rates under each program follows.

RATES FOR FOREIGN MILITARY SALES TRAINING

The Arms Export Control Act of 1976, as amended, allows for training to be provided to foreign nationals if the foreign governments agree to pay all direct and indirect costs.

Direct costs include such costs as the salary of civilian and military instructors; training material; equipment and supplies; petroleum; maintenance of aircraft, ships, and motorized vehicles; use of simulators; and operation and maintenance of airfields. The indirect costs charged under the foreign sales program include all costs associated with the general operation and maintenance of the training facility. These costs include family housing, food service activities, and operation of military personnel quarters, but do not include costs associated with the chapel, equal rights office, and special services. In addition, a 4-percent charge is applied to the total course cost to cover the depreciation of United States assets that are used in training foreign students.

RATES FOR INTERNATIONAL MILITARY
EDUCATION AND TRAINING

The Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, authorizes the Department of Defense to exclude the salaries and allowances of advisory personnel and other military personnel costs from the computed tuition rate for the training provided foreign students under this program. Except for

the cost elements discussed above, the tuition rate should include all other direct and indirect costs associated with training a foreign student under the program.

RATES FOR NORTH ATLANTIC
TREATY ORGANIZATION TRAINING

North Atlantic Treaty Organization countries are charged less by the United States than other countries under the Foreign Military Sales program. The tuition rates for North Atlantic Treaty Organization countries include only the direct costs of training. This waiver of indirect costs reduces tuition prices by 25 to 30 percent for personnel trained by the United States.
