

On May 14, 1996, the President submitted to the Congress his seventh special impoundment message for fiscal year 1996. The message reports one revised deferral of budget authority number D96-4A. We have reviewed the revised deferral contained in the seventh special message and found it to be in accordance with the Impoundment Control Act, 2 U.S.C. § 681, *et seq.*, as amended.
