MATTER OF: Key Security, Inc.

**DIGEST:**

Compliance with contract requirements is a contract administration matter not considered under GAO Bid Protest Procedures.

Key Security, Inc. (Key) has questioned the capability of Aseptic Services, Inc. (Aseptic) to comply with the requirements of its contract for guard services awarded under solicitation No. N00612-77-BB-0046 issued by the United States Navy.

Key was an unsuccessful bidder for this procurement and has submitted a list of at least eight alleged deficiencies by Aseptic in the performance of its contract.

Whether a contractor is complying with contract requirements is a matter of contract administration and is not appropriate for consideration as a bid protest. Robert Burger Associates, Inc., B-188450, June 1, 1977, 77-1 CPD 378 and Plaza de las Armas, Inc., B-188602, June 30, 1977, 77-1 CPD 468.

Accordingly, the protest is dismissed.
